CAMP MIKELL RULES

All campers should read and be familiar with the following rules. Campers will be held responsible for knowing and understanding the rules, which we believe, are necessary for building and maintaining our Christian Community.

1. Mikell is YOUR camp; therefore, we expect that you will help to keep Mikell clean and respect the facilities of this wonderful place.
2. NO Bullying. Bullying is a detriment to the Mikell community, is harmful to all involved, and is a serious offense. We believe in respecting the dignity and individuality of each and every person. Mikell has NO TOLERANCE for bullying.
3. Personal electronic music devices (iPods, CD players, etc.) are strongly discouraged. If you decide to bring a personal listening device, the use will be restricted to certain times in the dorms. We believe in building community, and we want you to interact with the other campers, counselors and staff.
4. No cell phones. We believe that camp is an opportunity for growth and independence. In case of an emergency, campers will be able to contact their parents or guardians and vice versa.
5. Camp Mikell is NOT responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged camper property brought to Mikell.
6. No weapons of any kind are allowed.
7. Respect the rights of other members of our Christian community by being quiet at rest times and after lights out; by respecting the property and privacy of others and by listening and following the guidance of leaders and counselors.
8. Campers may not possess alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs. Campers violating this standard will be sent home. All tobacco products are prohibited.
9. All prescription drugs will be registered with the nurse upon arrival at camp.
10. A lifeguard explains all waterfront rules.
11. Visitors are not allowed during camp sessions.
12. Always wear shoes, preferably closed-toe shoes.
13. Campers must remain in their cabins with counselors after lights out. Noise curfew is in effect at lights out.
14. Laundry facilities are not available for campers. Be sure to bring enough clothes.
15. No writing on anything, anywhere please.
16. Come to Camp Mikell expecting to be a part of a loving, caring, Christian community. Know if you invest yourself in the program fully and completely, you and all of us will be richer for this time we share together.
